How can South make Six Hearts after West leads the King of Diamonds?
Ruff the diamond lead, then play the rest of the hearts. Discard dummy's four top spades. Enter the board with the club Ace and lead the 8 of spades. East wins this and must return either another spade or a club, either of which gives you an entry to the South hand and the good clubs and spade.
