### How can South make Six Spades after West leads the King of Hearts?

North ruffs the lead and South must under-ruff! A spade is finessed with the 9, the diamonds played and then the Ace of clubs and a small club led. West is in again and leads another heart which is ruffed by North and again under-ruffed by South! North then leads diamonds until East trumps. South over-ruffs and wins the rest of the tricks.
