How can South make Six Spades after West leads the King of Hearts?

North ruffs the lead and South must under-ruff! A spade is finessed with the 9 , the diamonds played and then the Ace of clubs and a small club led. West is in again and leads another heart which is ruffed by North and again underruffed by South! North then leads diamonds until East trumps. South overruffs and wins the rest of the tricks.
